OFFICIAL JUDGES SEMINAR

Monday, November 28, 2005, The lecture will begin at 10:00 am and last from 2 to 3 hours. There will be a two hour break for lunch and to review your notes. This will be followed by a written examination, which should be able to be completed in an hour. Please be aware that in order to receive your IDO license, you will also be required to "mock judge", in the disciplines that you want to be qualified to judge, before the official license will be issued. The mock judging may be done at any World or Continental Championship, under the direction of the Chairman of Judges. Those who wish to do their "mock judging" at the Show Dance or Tap Dance events, should notify Mr. Bill Fowler.

All candidates must be nominated by an IDO member federation or contact person, and must have a national license issued by their National federation.

The fee to take this examination is 75 Euro, 50 Euro of which will be applied to your IDO Lifetime License.

Registration will begin at 9:30 am on the day of the seminar, however it is suggested that you inform the Senior Vice President, Mr. Bill Fowler, senior.president@ido-dance.com of your intention to attend. Please note: All candidates must be able to presents an official document, signed by their National Federation, that they are nominated to take the official seminar.

Please inform all candidates to be familiar with the entire IDO Rules Book, especially all sections that pertain to the duties of adjudicators, the scoring system and the code of ethics for both adjudicators, dancers and instructors/choreographers, along with the lecture by Matej Tusak, Ph. Dl, Important Psychological Issues in Relation to Evaluation and Estimation in Dance and the Adjudicators' Examination Study Notes, from which the examination questions will be based.
